

Oxenford is easily accessible and close to the major theme parks, is a popular choice with families and has become a strong residential area as opposed to the rural region it once was. Oxenford is synonymous with the northern Gold Coast's transformation in the past few years and is becoming increasingly popular as the urban sprawl spreads further away from the centre of the city

Residential

Houses in this region vary with some fantastic opportunities available. House prices vary depending on size and location but there is still land available with residential acreage still on offer. With a number of master planned communities and estates being developed in the area opportunities are endless. Waterfront homes are also available.

Shopping

Oxenford Central is a local shopping centre with a Woolworths as well as 16 other specialty stores. The closest major shopping centre is Westfield Helensvale which has a Kmart, Target, Woolworths and Aldi as well as a range of specialty stores.

Schools

Retirement

The Lodge in Upper Coomera is a 10-minute drive and accommodates 49 residents in purpose-built heritage-style cottages (co-located with The Homesteads Nursing Centre). Riverside Residential Resort on Riverbrooke Dr is a new riverfront over 50s resort offering two and three bedroom homes and full facilities. There are display homes on site.

Transport

Oxenford sits on the M1 Motorway so access to Brisbane and the southern Gold Coast is simple. Local buses in the area run twice an hour and the Helensvale train station is a five-minute drive away.

Recreation

This area is well located close to shopping centres as well as three of the Gold Coast's famous theme parks, Dreamworld, Movie World and Wet 'n' Wild. The Gold Coast City Marina is located nearby in Coomera with 200 water berths and everything needed for boating available. The Waterlife Restaurant & Café is available for a coffee, meal or functions. Numerous restaurants and cafes are situated at Westfield Helensvale, about five minutes away, as well as Options Tavern.

Golf

Gainsborough Greens Golf Course is an 18-hole, par 72 golf course that is recognised as a good course that once hosted the Queensland PGA for three years running. Visitors are welcome.
